

All,

Thank you for your on-going (or newly acquired) interest in LISC Neighborhood Health Partnership project. To date the consultants of Community Solution Inc. have collected data on our neighborhood and spent the entire month of March interviewing Mid-North residents. In addition to resident interviews, a portion of the data collected was made available by IU Health and Raphael Health Center. All the data is sorted in three focus areas, access to health services, access to healthy foods and access that encourages physical activity (parks, green spaces, infrastructure, etc.). Our current Mid-North Quality of Life Plan does have a small sub-section on health but does not address this in a full capacity, but we were recently a recipient of funds (from LISC Indianapolis via LISC National) to be a pilot site to expand what health means at a neighborhood level.

On Wednesday, May 7 (At The Renaissance Center, 3549 N. Boulevard Place) will be your <u>only</u> opportunity to look at the data collected and decide what information is important to make Mid-North a healthier place to live, work and play.
